

BROWN COUNTY FAIR ASSOCIATION CODE OF CONDUCT

All Brown County Youth and Open Division exhibitors and their parents/guardians (if applicable) agree to:

1. Follow the general rules and regulations governing entries, exhibits, judging, and payment of premiums as stated in the Fair Exhibitor's Book.
2. Follow any rules relating specifically to a department in which they are exhibiting.
3. Exhibit proper conduct according to the following guidelines:
 - a. Show respect for the rights of others and be courteous at all times
 - b. Respect the property of others
 - c. Demonstrate sportsmanship in the show ring, judging contests, and meetings
 - d. Be honest and not take unfair advantage of others
 - e. Refrain from loud, boisterous talk; foul language; and/or horseplay
 - f. No consumption of any alcoholic beverages or drugs (prescription drugs accepted) if under age of 21
 - g. Smoking or use of other tobacco products is prohibited if under age of 18

Violation of any of these rules may be grounds for the dismissal of individuals and groups. Reports of violations must be submitted in writing to the Brown County Fair Association (see section title "Resolution Committee" for process). Infractions will be dealt with through the Brown County Fair Association.
