RULES

1. Exhibitors must be enrolled in the Sheep Project or doing similar work in another youth organization to exhibit/show.
2. All market lambs entered in this division must be born after January 1 of the year shown.
3. All sheep may only be entered in 1 class except for the pen class.
4. All breeding sheep entered in Classes A-G will be shown at 1" of wool or less on any part of the body. Classes H-K will be shown with 2" of wool or less on any part of the body. All market classes must be with 3/8" of wool or less. It is suggested that sheep be sheared by June, which tends to follow the state-wide trend.
5. Only one entry per lot number.
6. A pen of market lambs shall consist of 2 market lambs owned by the exhibitor.
7. No one may approach the judge before or during the show. Technical questions should be directed to the ring steward, superintendent, or if they are not available, to the fair office. Exhibitors are encouraged to thank the judge for their work after the show is complete.

AGE CLASSIFICATIONS

(5) Sheep.

A spring lamb is one born on or after February 16 of the exhibit year.

A fall lamb is one born between September 1 and December 31 of the year preceding the exhibit year.

A winter lamb is one born between January 1 and February 15 of the exhibit year.

A yearling ram or ewe is one born outside the date of birth limitations in par. (a) through (c). The age of yearling may be subject to verification by a veterinarian's examination whose findings shall be final.

A market lamb is one born after January 1 of the exhibit year.
