3. See pages 10-12 for animal health requirements.
4. The Animal Stall, Pen & Cage Reservation Form must be included with the Open & Senior Division Entry Form. No entries will be considered unless both of these forms are submitted. Horse stabling will be given on a first come basis, with initial consideration given to Junior Division Exhibitors. At the time of entry, please indicate the number of horse stalls requested. There is a \$10 deposit for horse stalls. Please write out a separate check for stall deposits. Deposit will be refunded after the fair providing a horse occupied the stall for the duration of the fair. No one is allowed a tack stall, unless otherwise assigned by superintendent after all horses have stalls. Trailering in and out for the show will only be allowed if no stalls are available.
5. No person under 18 years of age will be permitted to handle stallions. Stallion owners may have the option to trailer in and out day of the show.
6. An exhibitor can enter a horse in more than 2 classes, but will receive premiums for the top 2 placings.
7. Exercising horses and cleaning of stalls is to be done before 10:00 a.m. each day and also between 3:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. each day (except on Sunday). Any changes or additions will be posted in barns.
8. Exhibitor showing in Junior classes cannot cross enter into open class with the same horse and rider combination shown in the Junior Horse Project. No Junior Horse Project exhibitor who cross enters in Open Class will receive premiums in any open horse classes.
9. Exhibitors must read over Junior rules and follow all that apply to everyone, such as rules on helmets, boots, etc.
10. Any horse that kicks or causes a disturbance in the ring may be disqualified by the judge.
11. All horses entered in any class must be sound and free from disease; (see animal health requirements).
12. Exhibits entered in registered purebred classes should be prepared to show registration papers to superintendent at time of arrival.
13. All horses must have a valid, negative Coggins test. The original to be shown to the superintendent and a copy to be give to the superintendent for the 4-H office to retain.
14. Open class can enter Gymkhana classes and Model Horse classes. Judging will be held in conjunction with junior classes.
