**RULES**

4. The Animal Stall, Pen & Cage Reservation Form must be included with the Open & Senior Division Entry Form.  
No entries will be considered unless both of these forms are submitted.
5. No fowl or any type of class showing any symptoms of a contagious or infectious disease may not be exhibited at a fair or show in the state.
6. The State Department of Agriculture, or the Fair Management, reserves the right to have an approved veterinarian examine all fowl and to exclude any fowl at that time for cause. Any exhibit excluded will be returned to the owner or slaughtered, at the option of the attending veterinarian or the State Department of Agriculture. If slaughtered, any return for the sale of the birds will be remitted directly to the owner.
7. All fowl exhibited may be subject to quarantine and slaughtered if any infectious or contagious disease is discovered among any of the fowl in the exhibit.
8. No birds may be entered in any other name than that of the owner.
9. All birds must be tagged with entry tags issued by the fair coordinator under one lot number.
10. Only one entry per lot number.
11. Exhibitors failing to properly care for animals at the fair will forfeit all premiums.
12. Exhibitors must bring their own feed and containers for feeding and watering.
