

**2008 Brown County Fair**  
**Rules & Expectations for Exhibitors Staying Overnight at the Fairgrounds**

Youth exhibitors who want to stay at the fairgrounds during the Brown County Fair must complete and return the permission slip below to the Brown County Fair Association by July 28, 2008. The Brown County Fair Association will provide 24-hour security for the fairgrounds during the week of the Fair. Buildings will close at 11:30 p.m. each evening and will be regularly monitored by security officials. Youth must be accompanied by an adult chaperone in the building. One chaperone per building must be awake at all times in compliance with fire codes.

Any actions and/or behaviors of a Fair exhibitor who is staying in the barns that is deemed inappropriate by the chaperone(s), superintendent(s), Brown County Fair Association members and/or security personnel will result in disciplinary action up to and including immediate banning from staying in the barns overnight. Specific infractions that can result in discipline or dismissal from the fairgrounds and barns include but are not limited to the following:

**Adult chaperones (18 years of age and older/ 21 and older for 4-H participants) are expected to stay in the barns from 11:30 p.m. to dawn. The ratio is one adult to 10 youth. No alcohol may be consumed by adult chaperones while on duty.**
